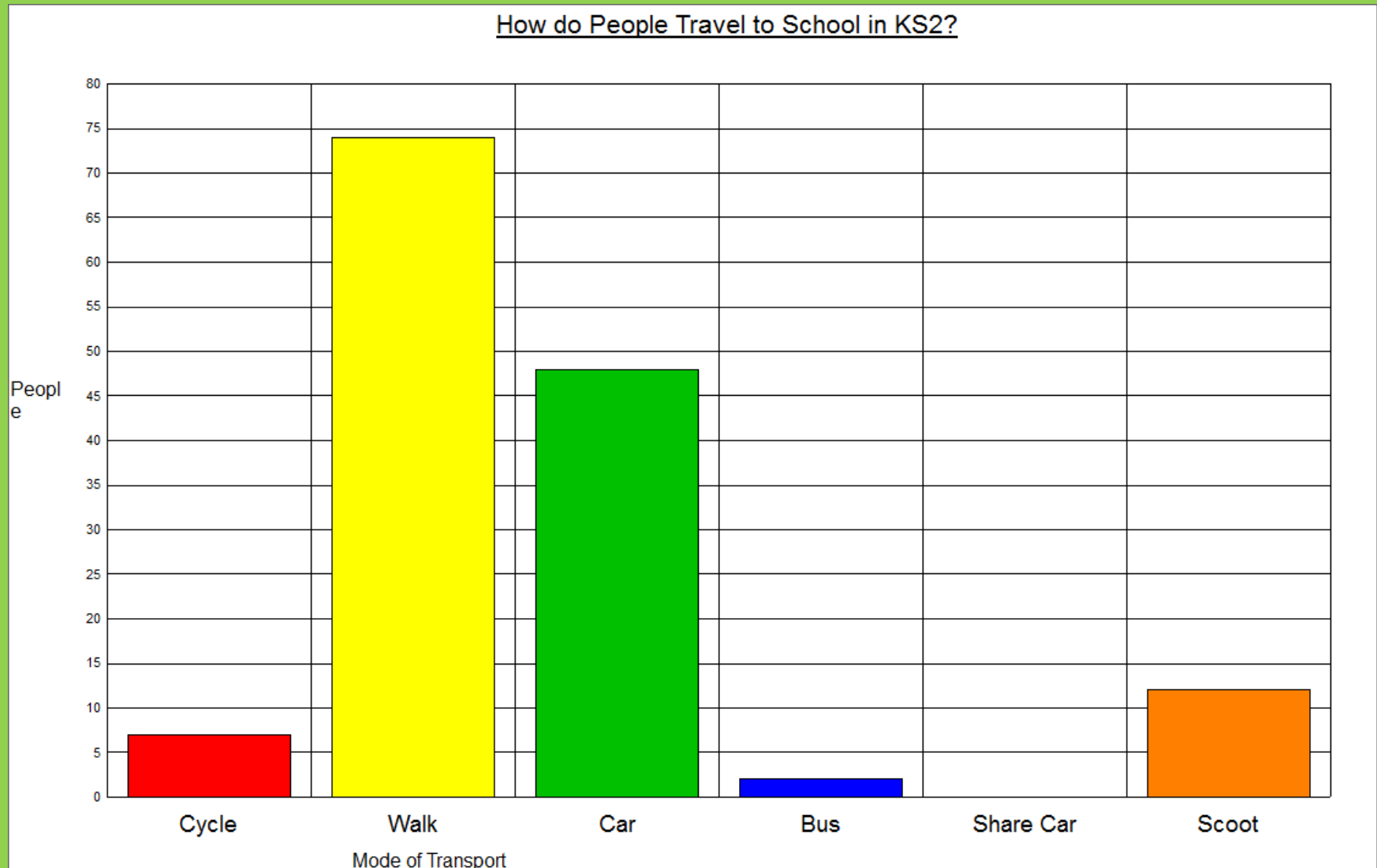

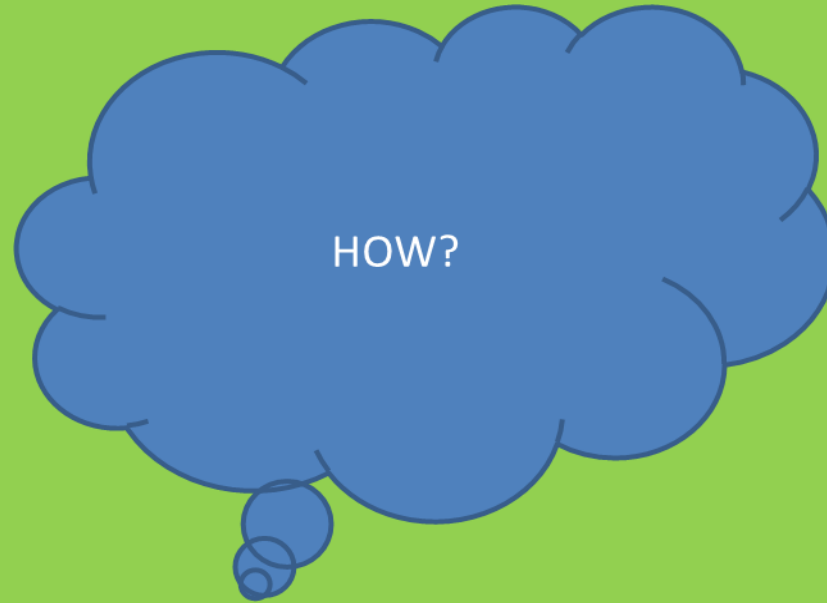

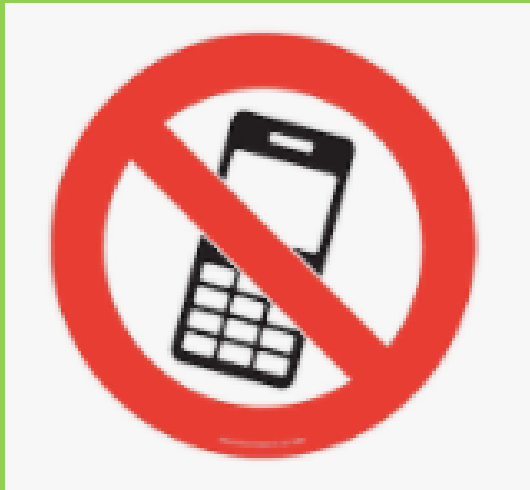
REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF ELECTRICITY WE USE

We can turn off all electrical appliances when not using them.

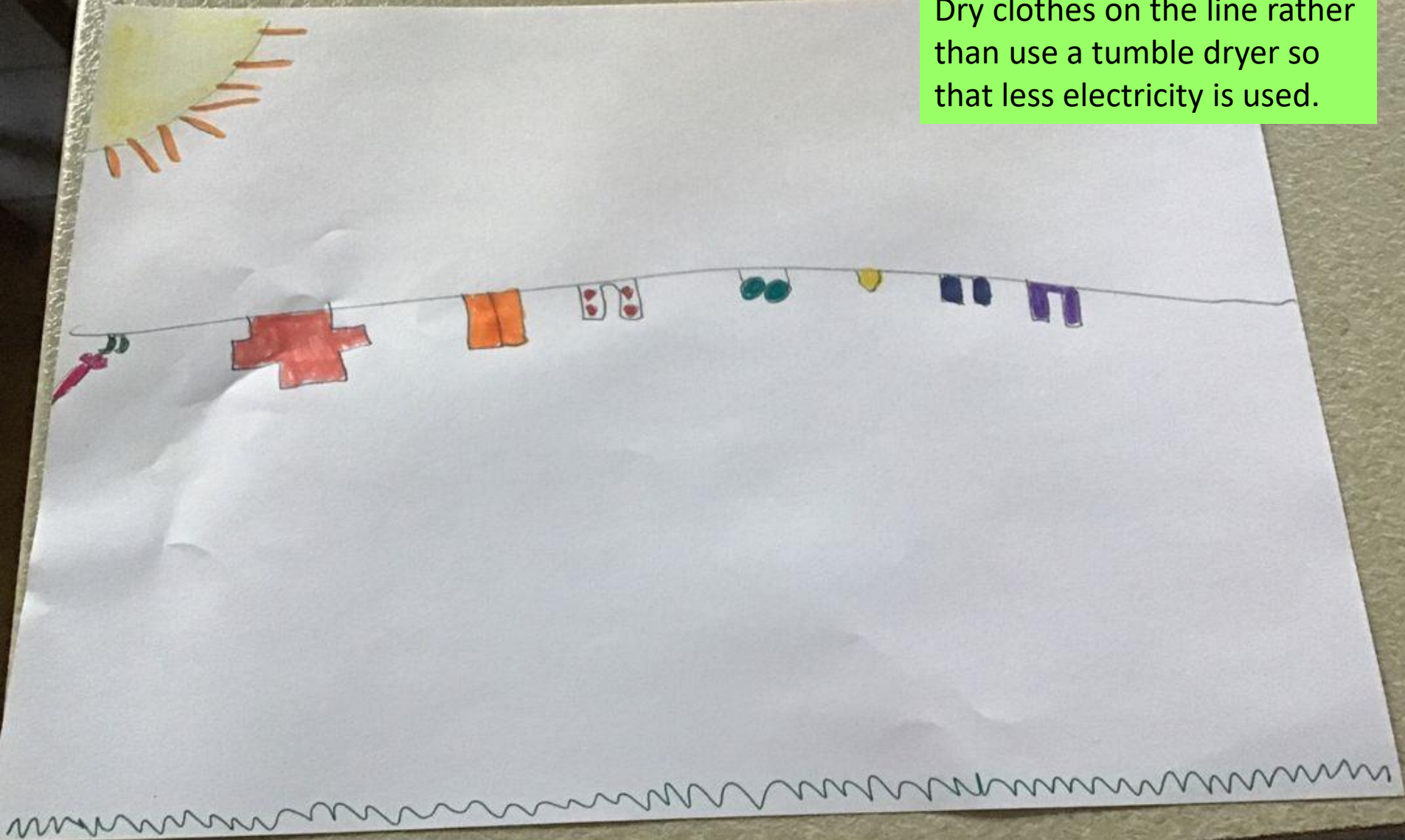




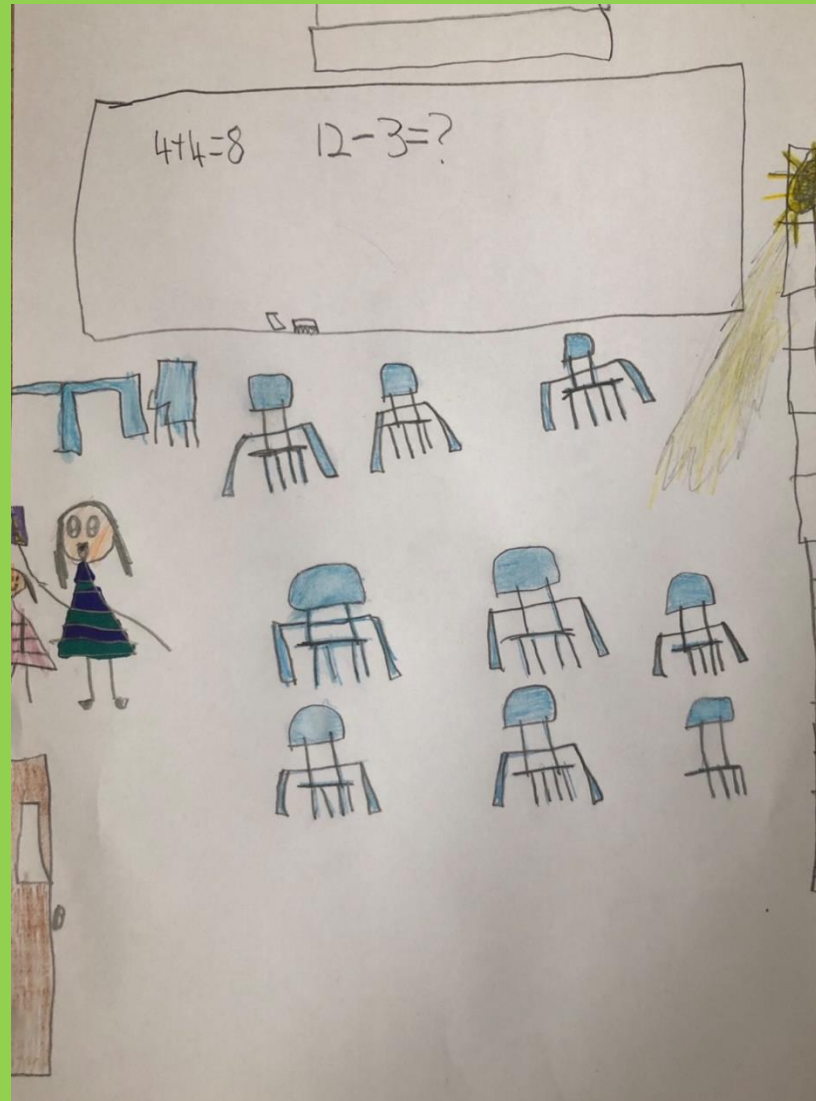


Wash clothes at 20c so that we use less electricity heating the water.

Dry clothes on the line rather than use a tumble dryer so that less electricity is used.



Remind our teachers to keep the windows clear so that we use the lights less often and to turn off the lights when we're not in the room.



Shower instead of bathing so that we heat less water and so use less electricity.



# REDUCE and RE-USE



We need to reduce the amount of fuel we use making and moving because when we keep on using fuel to make and produce goods it means that gases are released into the atmosphere (air) which makes the temperature.

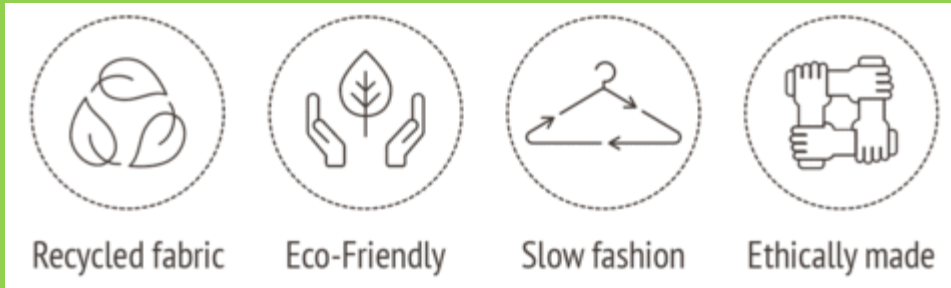

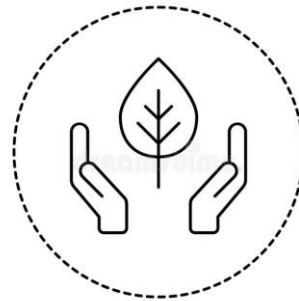
**Remember to use both sides of a piece of paper:**
