We are very aware that children of all ages are seeing and hearing lots about the current devastating situation in Ukraine. The news and social media feeds are filled with the latest information, and some of it is very upsetting and worrying. Whilst we are geographically far away from the events, it will affect everyone differently, and many in our communities will be directly affected. We need to be sensitive and prepared to answer any questions the children may have.

At school this will be discussed in an age appropriate way dealing directly with children's comments and not elaborating in any way. We will also keep in our prayers the people suffering both in Ukraine and Russia, throughout this season of Lent, which started last Wednesday.

We are aware that you may be concerned about how to address some of the issues raised by children at home.
